### *Commission Action Requested*

Approval of preliminary and final site and building plans pursuant to 40 U.S.C. § 8722(b)(1).

### *Commission Action*

The Commission:

**Approves** the preliminary and final site and building plans for Building 17, combining a Physical Fitness Center, Administrative Facility and Parking Garage on the National Naval Medical Center Campus in Bethesda, Maryland as shown on NCPC Map File No. 3101.30(38.00)42940.

**Encourages** the Department of the Navy to preserve as many trees and natural features as possible when constructing necessary electrical site work and walkway connections beyond the site proper.

**Notes** that the Department of the Navy has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Maryland State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) that requires: further documentation of the exterior historic elements and surrounding landscape of Building 17; the restoration of the historic facades of Building 17 including the entrance doors, entrance canopies, and steps; and further review by the SHPO of project specifications to ensure their compatibility with the defining features of historic Building 17 and other historic resources on the installation.
