**Approves** the final site development plans for the Georgetown Waterfront Park, Phase III, Development of Bikeway and Promenade from Thompson Boat Center to the Kennedy Center, as shown on NCPC Map File No. 1.33(70.00)43216, using either the Sycamore trees (London Planetree) newly planted along the Rock Creek and Potomac Parkway in 2009 or the alternative variety of Sycamore tree (Liberty Planetree) proposed by the National Park Service, or an appropriate alternative that grows no taller than the Liberty Planetree, provided funds are made available to the National Park Service.
