### *Commission Action*

The Commission:

**Approves** the preliminary and final site and building plans for the Corridor 2 and 3 pedestrian screening facilities located at the Pentagon as shown on NCPC Map File No. 1.62(38.00)43268.

**Commends** the applicant for developing entrance screening facilities that respect and complement the historic nature of the Pentagon, incorporate state of the art screening technology, and allow for employees to efficiently enter and exit the building.

**Finds** that through consultation with NCPC and CFA the designs for the Corridor 2 and 3 pedestrian screening facilities have improved and appreciates the applicant's willingness to address concerns raised over the past few months.
