Commission Action Requested by Applicant

Approval of preliminary and final site development plans pursuant to 40 U.S.C. § 8722(d) and Section 5 of the National Capital Planning Act (40 U.S.C. § 8722(b)(1)).

Commission Action

The Commission:

Approves the preliminary and final site development plans for perimeter security at the E. Barrett Prettyman U.S. Courthouse Annex rotunda in northwest Washington, DC **depicted in Alternative Proposal 1, except for the bollards at the west end of the project site and the bollards at the corner of 3rd Street NW and Constitution Avenue, NW**, as shown on NCPC Map File No. 1.24(38.00)-41432.

Commends the General Services Administration for incorporating bollard-reinforced planters that also serve as seating for pedestrians into the perimeter security design.

Requires the General Services Administration to incorporate a raised landscape planter into the existing landscaping at the west end of the project site in lieu of the proposed bollards; and to utilize the bollard arrangement depicted in Alternative Proposal 2 for the corner of 3rd Street, NW and Constitution Avenue, NW.
