Approval of site selection and design guidelines pursuant to Public Law 96-297 and the Commemorative Works Act (40 U.S.C. 8905).

Commission Action

That the National Park Service submit a study of the Interior South Building front yard, along with any other sites, to determine if they are feasible for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Center using the same level of analysis previously undertaken for the other sites considered as well as a reexamination of site G.

That the applicant provide additional information on the Center's proposed building program to enable the Commission to better understand the impacts that the Center might be likely to have above ground on any site.
