Approval of final building plans pursuant to 40 U.S.C. § 8722(b)(1) and (d).

Commission Action

The Commission:

Approves the preliminary and final building plans for the installation of six transmitting/receiving antennas, one receiving antenna, and associated equipment at the Department of Interior South Annex Building, 1951 Constitution Ave, NW, as shown on NCPC Map File No. 1.35(38.30)42234, for a period not to exceed five years.

Recommends that the Department of Interior secure access to the building roof areas and ensure that necessary radio frequency (RF) information signs are placed at all rooftop access points in a highly visible fashion.

Recommends that the Department of Interior post roof drawings on the penthouse walls and/or doorways indicating areas where the antennas are located.
