The Commission:

Approves the final adoption of the updated Federal Elements of the Comprehensive Plan. Policies will be effective 60-days after adoption. After the effective date:

- Projects that have preliminary approval under the old policies, will move forward using the old 2004 Comprehensive Plan policies.
- Projects that have no preliminary approval will move forward using the new 2016 Comprehensive Plan policies.
- Under special and unusual circumstances, applicant agencies can consult with NCPC staff to determine the applicable Comprehensive Plan policies.

Notes NCPC and NPS are currently undertaking a Small Parks Study. Following the completion of the study, NCPC will update the Parks & Open Space Element. The 2004 Parks & Open Space Element policies will remain in effect until updated.

Notes following Commission adoption, staff will incorporate any changes as directed by the Commission, and will complete minor editorial updates to the text and graphics to ensure document accuracy and consistency.
