The Commission:

Approves the preliminary site development plans for the new guard booth and fence augmentation at the US Department of Homeland Security's Nebraska Avenue Complex.

Requests that GSA add landscaping to the two areas of chain link fence with barbed wire that can be viewed from public space to minimize visual impacts throughout the year. These include:

- The section of fence at the most northern edge of the campus parallel to the NBC driveway off Nebraska Avenue.
- The section of fence that is visible from the Massachusetts-39th Street Trail in Glover –Archbold Park.

Requests that GSA submit a Final Master Plan for the Nebraska Avenue Complex as a follow-up to the Commission's recommendations on the Draft Master Plan it reviewed in May of 2011.
