The Commission:

**Approves** the preliminary site development plans for modifications to the streetscape and site security elements at the National Law Enforcement Museum, consisting of the elimination of the two lay-bys, new curb alignment and planting strips, and installation of security bollards.

**Notes** the proposed modifications to the site development plan to address security concerns, consisting of the reconfigured bollard alignment will be in place until the District of Columbia Courts and the U.S. Court of Military Appeals extend their portions of the southern E Street, NW curb line to widen the sidewalks, as approved in the Judiciary Square Master Plan.

**Notes** the applicant worked with staff to identify a revised bollard configuration on the west side of the museum's entrance pavilion.

**Finds** the configuration of the below grade structure of the museum and the type of retractable bollard type impact the configuration and placement of the proposed security bollards along E Street, NW.

**Notes** that Public Law 106-942 requires consultation and coordination with the District of Columbia Courts throughout the duration of the project.
