The Commission:

Approves the preliminary site development plans for signage within Rock Creek National Park.

Supports NPS's goal to provide a unified signage design for Rock Creek National Park identity, project concise and consistent messaging, and consolidate signage to reduce visual clutter and redundancy.

Notes that the signage plan is consistent with NPS standards and previously approved signage programs for the National Mall and Memorial Parks.

Notes that NPS has committed to providing full size mock-ups of typical signs for staff review prior to final submission.

Notes that specific installation locations and signage scales will be provided as part of the final review submission.

Recommends that NPS further evaluate the type and amount of signage proposed for Meridian Hill Park, given its National Historic Landmark status, and continue consultation with the District of Columbia State Historic Preservation Officer to evaluate potential adverse effects of any new signage.
