The Commission:

**Approves** the targeted accessibility improvements at the Thomas Jefferson Memorial, consisting of two new ramps on the north side of the memorial, to improve accessibility for all visitors.

**Notes** the Thomas Jefferson Memorial currently has only one accessible route to the statuary chamber level, which requires visitors arriving from the north to use a ramp on the south side of the memorial and traverse back to access the lower level entrances.
