The Zoning Commission of the District of Columbia has referred an application for a text amendment regarding the construction of accessory structures planned at the RFK Campus in Southeast Washington, DC. The application proposes modifications to Subtitle A, Section 209.2 to allow for four accessory structures, including two restroom facilities. Current zoning allows three structures and one restroom. The Fields at RFK is a recreational complex that was recently completed and has been quite successful, requiring additional restroom facilities. NCPC will review the new restroom as a District project submitted by Events DC.

The proposed amendment would not be inconsistent with the Federal Elements of the *Comprehensive Plan for the National Capital*, nor would it adversely affect any other federal interests. NCPC reviewed a previous text amendment (ZC 18-04) regarding accessory structures at the campus as a delegated action and also did not find any adverse impacts to the federal interest. The addition of one restroom does not alter that finding.

Pursuant to delegations of authority adopted by the Commission on August 6, 1999 and per 40 U.S.C. § 8724(a) and DC Code § 2-1006(a), I find that the proposed text amendment to Subtitle A, Sections 209.2, regarding accessory structures at the RFK Campus would not be inconsistent with the Federal Elements of the *Comprehensive Plan for the National Capital*, nor would it adversely affect any other identified federal interests.
