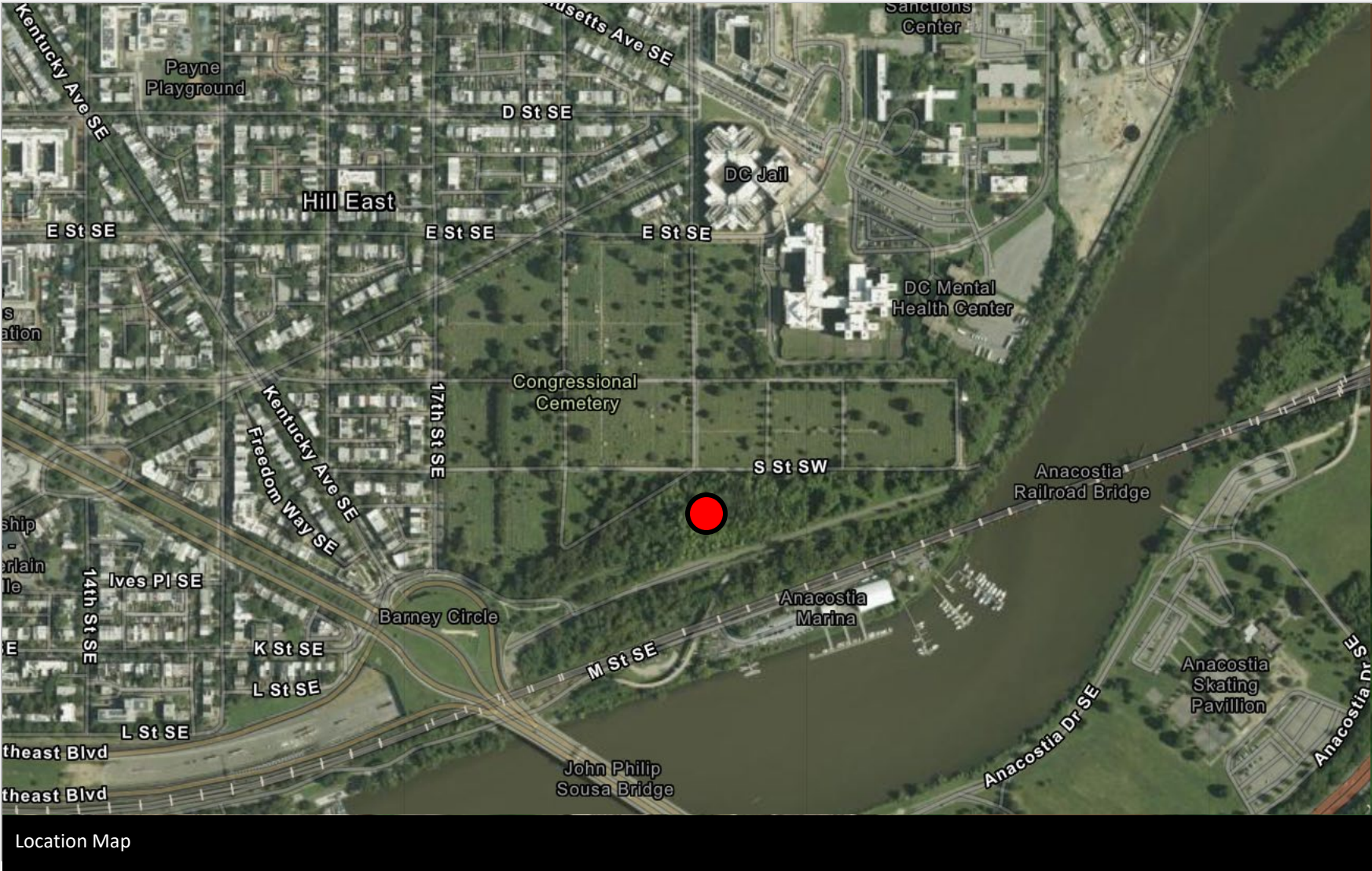
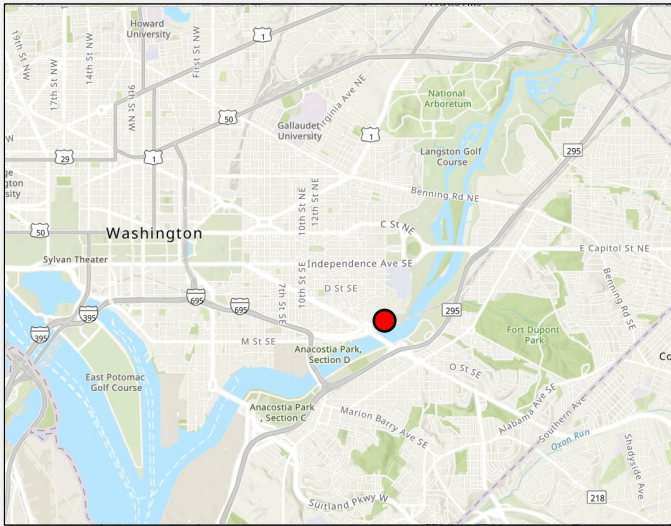

Project Summary:

The National Park Service submitted a transfer of administrative jurisdiction over approximately 17.23 acres of Reservation 343F (between the RFK Campus and Barney Circle) from the National Park Service to the District of Columbia. Title to the property will remain with the United States. Under the transfer, the District assumes responsibility for the property's operation, maintenance, administration, and permitting, subject to recorded covenants requiring that the property be used for transportation, recreation, and related public purposes and preserving applicable environmental and historic preservation protections.
