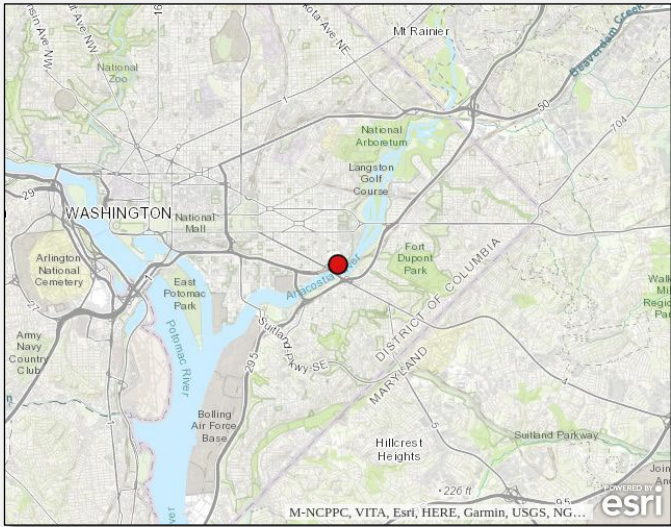

Project Summary:

The National Park Service (NPS) has initiated a transfer of administrative jurisdiction over a portion of U.S. Reservation 343F, located between the Robert f. Kennedy Memorial Stadium (RFK) Campus and Commodore Barney Circle in Southeast Washington, DC, at the request of the District of Columbia. The proposed transfer will allow the District to assume responsibility for the maintenance, operation, administration, and permitting of the transfer property. The title to the land will remain vested with the United States government. The proposed transfer includes 17.2339 acres within Squares 1117-S, 1124, 1131, 1147, 1149-S, and 1152, as well as a portion of Reservation 343F. The applicant will issue a Declaration of Covenants with the transfer to the use and management of the property so that it will only be used for transportation, recreation, and related public purposes.

The transfer has also been coordinated with the District of Columbia State Historic Preservation Office (DCSHPO) in connection with compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA). NPS and DC SHPO have determined that the transfer of control and jurisdiction from the Federal Government to the District will not adversely affect historic properties because the transfer itself does not authorize physical changes to the property and future projects will remain subject to applicable District historic preservation requirements.
