

The Dupont Circle BID's collaboration with the Cherry Blossom Festival for an outdoor art installation

PROPOSAL

Install temporary art (Cherry Blossom statue) in the cobblestone area in Q Street Park NW (across the North entrance of the Dupont Circle Metrorail Station) from April 14th through May 31st, 2021.



PURPOSE

The statue is a part of the Cherry Blossom Festival's *Art in Bloom* project. The statue will be painted to reflect themes of The Cherry Blossom Festival and the District. It can be sat in, and the project aims to provide a socially distant way for the public to enjoy city-based artwork during the Cherry Blossom Festival.



LOCATION

Q Street Park NW located across from the North entrance of the Dupont Circle Metro Station





SCULPTURE

Dimensions: The sculpture measures 57.5 in W x 53.25 in H x 35 in deep. The concrete base it's affixed to (via threaded steel rods & bolts) measures 3 ft W x 5 ft 2 in L x 7.5 in H - With the base included, the piece will be just over 5 ft tall.

Materials: The sculpture is made of fiberglass with steel armature (partial interior frame) for sturdiness. Both the sculpture and the base have a combined weigh at least 850 lbs.



Note: the statue will be painted by a local artists prior to installation.
