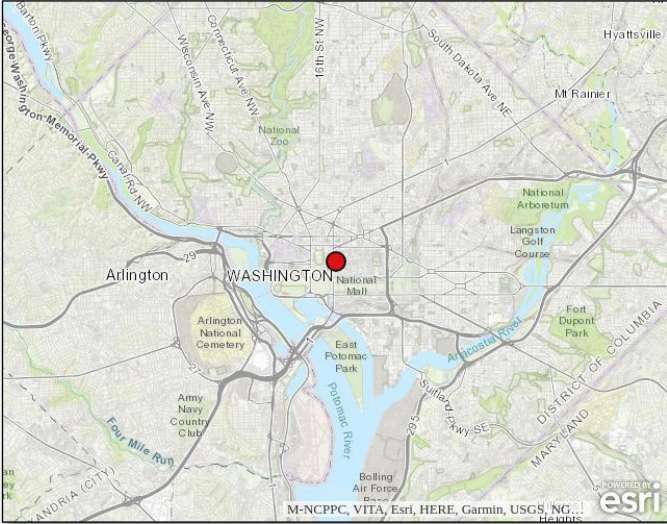
Project Summary:

The National Park Service (NPS) has submitted preliminary and final site development plans to temporarily place the Caesar Rodney Statue on Freedom Plaza for a period not to exceed 6 months.

The statue will be on loan to the NPS from the State of Delaware and is being placed in Freedom Plaza as part of the celebrations leading into the 250th Anniversary of the American Independence on July 4, 2026.

The bronze portion of the statue is 16-feet long, 7 feet wide, and 9 feet tall that will sit on a 12-foot tall, 16 foot long and 7-foot-wide concrete base.
