NCPC to Review Intelligence Community Campus-Bethesda Master Plan

Lafayette Building Streetscape and Site Improvements Also on Agenda

Washington, DC – At its monthly meeting on <u>Thursday, February 2 at 12:30 p.m.</u> the National Capital Planning Commission (NCPC) will review a proposed final master plan submitted by the US Army Corps of Engineers to convert an approximately 39-acre federal facility on Sangamore Road in Bethesda, Maryland into a secure Intelligence Community Campus. The Commission deferred action on the Master Plan at its December 2011 meeting and requested the applicant conduct further analysis on the proposed parking garage.

The next item on the agenda is a submission by the General Services Administration for streetscape and site improvements at the Lafayette Building, a federally owned building located at 811 Vermont Avenue, NW.
