NCPC Hosts Public Hearing on Height Master Plan Today Public comment period also closes today

Washington, DC – Today, Wednesday, October 30, 2013 at 4:30 pm the National Capital Planning Commission (NCPC) will host a public hearing where the public will have an opportunity to provide comments and testimony on the reports prepared by NCPC and the District of Columbia for the Height Master Plan for Washington, DC. The meeting, originally planned for earlier in the month, was rescheduled due to the shutdown of the federal government.

Those wishing to speak can register either at the meeting, or in advance online. The order of speakers will be determined by the order in which people registered, with requests received in advance going first. On-site testimony sign-in begins at 3:30 pm, followed by the meeting which begins promptly at 4:30 pm

Final action on the Height Master Plan will take place at a subsequent Special Commission Meeting on Tuesday, November 19 at 2:00 pm. Following Commission action, NCPC's report and recommendations will be transmitted to Congress. The deadline to sign-up to provide public testimony is November 18 at noon.
